- Undertake scheduled standardization training and re-certification

Qualifications:

- An undergraduate degree or equivalent OR a Master's degree or equivalent in a related field or area.
- Recognized TESOL qualification
- Minimum of 3 years TESOL teaching experience. Full-time teaching is classified as a minimum of 14 hours of face-to-face teaching per week. An applicant must be able to provide evidence that they have a minimum of 1500 hours of relevant TESOL teaching over 3 years. Almost all of this experience must be to students aged 16 and over.
