



**Two .8 Definite Term Lecturer Positions – EMLS Lecturers

Renison University College, affiliated with the University of Waterloo, and located on the territories of the Anishinaabe, Haudenosaunee and Attawandaron (Neutral) peoples, invites applications for two, .8 (four/fifths of full time) three-year definite-term appointments at the rank of Lecturer, responsible for teaching English for Multilingual Speakers (EMLS) courses in the English Language Studies unit of the Culture and Language Studies department.

Successful candidates will have a graduate degree in TESL, Applied Linguistics, or a related field, and TESL Ontario (or equivalent TESL Canada) certification. The individual will teach EMLS courses on-campus and possibly online totalling 6 term courses per year: three in fall terms, and three in winter terms, with spring terms off. Some service work is required. The individual should have substantial teaching experience in the field of English for Academic Purposes (EAP) with strong evidence of success. Experience with online teaching and teaching credit EAP at both undergraduate and graduate levels are considered assets. The ability to work collaboratively is important. The salary range for this position at the rank of Lecturer begins at \$49,500.00. An appointment date of 1 September 2018 is preferred.
